The Columbia River Estuary Study Taskforce (CREST) is announcing the opportunity to submit proposals for the Warren Slough restoration project. For this project **CREST requires a contractor with specific railroad and/or roadway infrastructure expertise as well as experience working in wetlands and tidal waterways.** This project is scheduled to commence in **Summer 2024, work must be completed July 15 to September 30, 2024.** 

This is a prevailing wage contract and it meets all federal and state contracting guidelines. Applicants must be registered and in good standing with the federal SAM (System for Award Management). Furthermore, contractors will be asked to state that they have been prequalified, registered, and in good standing with the Construction Contractor's Board (CCB), and not been debarred, suspended, or otherwise excluded. The project is sponsored by CREST and the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA). BPA is the main project funder, with various Federal and State Agencies and Private Landowners as project partners. Materials are subject to the Buy America, Build America Act provisions for all of the iron, steel, manufactured products, and construction materials used in the project.
