**Dear RFP Holder:**

The following addenda apply to the Woodland Island: Year 1 Planting RFP. Project proposals are still due by **April 2, 2021 at 4pm**.

### **Clarification on Contractor's Licensing Requirements**

Because this project takes place entirely within the state of Washington, the selected contractor must have a current Washington contractor's license in good standing. Contractors are not required to be licensed for business in Oregon.

### **Clarification Regarding Insurance Provider**

In the RFP, section "I. Liability" states that the contractor's insurance company must be licensed to do business in the State of Oregon. This is incorrect, as the work will take place in Washington. The contractor's insurance agent must be licensed to do business in the State of Washington; licensure in Oregon is not required.

### **Additional Specifications for Select Plant Stock**

In response to questions about size requirements for certain plants stocks, CREST is providing additional specifications for live stake and plug plant materials. For the purpose of bidding and contracting, please use the following specifications for live stakes and plugs.
